Class 1 Mini Pairs (<u>walk/trot only</u> - may be lead or assisted)

6 race minimum session designed to build confidence, whilst having fun with others - 75 minutes with rest time between races - single heat, games as detailed below

Class 2 Junior - Area 2024 junior team games - 90minute duration

2a Junior Teams

2b Novice Junior Pairs (team races) looking to develop their love of games at a steadier pace with support where appropriate.

Class 3 Senior - Area 2024 senior team games - 90 duration

3a Senior Teams

3b Novice Senior Pairs (team races) looking to develop their love of games at a steadier pace with simplified races if required.

Juniors/Seniors will run through each Area team race twice

- first run through is a practice (heat)
- second run through is a "race off" for points (final)

Run under friendly, supportive competition conditions, a perfect opportunity put Area race skills to the test against others

Individual PC member entries welcome in ALL classes - we will do our best to find a suitable partner/team

Guidance & Rules

- Entries are accepted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor and their representative.
- This is a friendly get together aimed at Pony Club Branch & Centre members new to mounted games and working towards Area competitions. We will do our best to offer riders, parents and volunteer officials help. No question is a silly one, please ask.
- It will be run under the guidance of the PC Mounted Games 2024 rule book.
- Please can each Branch nominate at least one adult/parent trainer to assist their Branch members in the arena during races.
- Parents will be expected to assist with line steward and arena party duties guidance will be provided.
- All ages as of 01.01.2024 <u>however in the case of senior riders with little riding</u> experience it may be more appropriate for them to ride in the junior section.
- Help remounting (by designated Branch official) is permitted to encourage participation and development.
- Weight rules apply to all competitors as PC Rule book.
- Team riders to wear white sweatshirts and their Branch mounted games bibs. Pairs may wear PC Branch sweat shirts & matching coloured hat silks - spare bibs & hat silks will be available.
- · Hair secured above shoulders, ideally in hairnets, no long plaits/ponytails please.
- Rider parents/guardians to carry out a tack & rider check before entering the arena.
- Rough/dangerous riding will not be tolerated and may result in elimination without refund.
- Ponies must not be tied up outside lorry/trailer & LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME.
- Haynets/bags inside trailers/lorries only.
- Please clear all muck & litter around your trailer/lorry & take it home.
- · Children to be supervised at all times please.
- Team trainers will be emailed a list of their Branch entries two days before the closing date of Saturday 27/04/24
- Team entries MUST authorised by a Pony Club registered team trainer or DC.
- Signed team declaration form to be submitted at least 45min before class starts.

I hereby acknowledge that before making an entry I have carefully read the rules under which this event is to be held and, on behalf of the Pony Club Branch I represent, I agree in all respects to comply with and be bound by these rules.

Legal liability

Health & Safety

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precaution to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. Withdrawals - £5 admin fee per class may be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to email notification of withdrawal prior to the event. *3. Tyre (Novice version)

Rider 1 rides to centre line, <u>where a helper holds pony</u> whilst they lift tyre over head to feet, re-mount (assistance/leg up allowed), ride to finish at changeover - Rider 2 repeats heading down the arena.

*4. Farmers Market (Novice version) - grooming box starts on table at centre line.
Items to be collected from helper at changeover - bottle, bean bag, string sausages, sock
*6. Sharp Shooter (Novice version) - bend to bucket, throw beanbag until ONE enters upturned bin, remount & bend back to finish
